

Additional Novice Maneuver - to be included in competition on a trial basis

A5. Half Pirouette

Model takes off from the central helipad and ascends vertically, skids to eye level and stops. The model then turns 90 degrees to the left or right as elected by the pilot. Then without pausing turns 180 degrees (with the tail turning towards the pilot) until the model faces the opposite direction. The helicopter then without pausing turns 90 degrees until the model is once again tail in to the pilot, pauses then lands. For the entire manoeuvre the model is to maintain a position over the centre of the helipad.

Points will be deducted for the following reasons:

1. The main shaft of the Model drifts away from the centre line of the Heli pad.
2. Helicopter fails to 'pirouette' to a position 90 degrees to the pilot.
3. Model did not take off or land smoothly on the centre of the Heli pad.
